General Volunteer Policies

All Volunteers Must:

- Be at least 18 years of age or older.
- Read and agree to abide by the Volunteer Code of Conduct, Volunteer Policies and Modesty Policies.
- All volunteer forms must be submitted to the Partnership for Youth office by June 14th. Volunteers registering after this date will not be guaranteed housing at the conference.
- Complete a background check form if they are from the Diocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis and have not previously (within the past 5 years) completed a background check for the diocese.
- Work in the area assigned to him/her. Partnership for Youth will assign the volunteer to designated areas. The volunteer will receive notification and a job description from Partnership for Youth the month prior to the conference.
- Strictly adhere to the schedule and job description given to them by Partnership for Youth.
- Strictly adhere to the modesty policies set by Partnership for Youth.
- Sit in the volunteer section when not working.
- Be in compliance with the USCCB Charter for the Protection of God's Children. Each diocese has its requirements to meet in order to be in compliance.
- Volunteers must complete Volunteer Training the date offered or make alternate arrangements.
- All Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist must be commissioned by the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis.
- If you are going to be driving to and from the event, you must have a valid driver's license.
- Create an environment of peace by working together to bring the love of God to everyone at the conference.
