



Rise Up Twin Cities – 2019 Registration & Payment Policies

Registration

Registration opens at 9:00 am CST on Tuesday, October 2, 2018. Tickets are \$60 per person and include conference entry and lunch. Additional Mall of America experience opportunities, conference t-shirts and other items will be available for purchase after receipt of your conference deposit. Registration for Rise Up Twin Cities is by group (church, organization, family, etc.). Partnership for Youth will not accept individual registrations or payments.

How to Register

All registrations are processed online. The Group Leader should purchase all tickets on behalf of the entire group. A non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit of \$30 per person must be received to confirm registration and can be made by credit card at the time of registration. (After January 23, 2019, full payment is due at the time of registration.) If you choose “Invoice” and will send a check, your space will be held for 2 weeks and will be cancelled if not received within 2 weeks. Upon receipt of your deposit, additional Mall of America experience opportunities, conference t-shirts and kneeling pads will be made available for purchase, along with your final balance. You may register for additional tickets (availability permitting) by contacting PFY or completing the online process again and indicating that these are an add-on to an existing group.

Deadlines and Cancelations

Deposits are non-refundable, non-transferrable and will not be applied to the final group balance. You can reduce your total tickets up until the final payment deadline, January 23, 2019. **After January 23, 2019, full payment is due at the time of registration.**

- Final group payment is due on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 and can be made by check or through the online process (link will be provided upon receipt of your deposit).
- Final payments made by check must be postmarked no later than January 23, 2019 to avoid a late charge.
- A \$10/ticket late payment fee will apply to all groups not paid in full by the payment deadline.
- Groups that have not paid in full by the deadline and choose to reduce tickets or cancel will be held responsible for paying the full balance for all space reserved as of January 23, 2019.

Mall of America Attraction Opportunities

Additional Mall of America attraction tickets will be available for purchase at exclusive rates after receipt of your conference deposit. Groups are limited to one attraction ticket per-person at the exclusive rate. If you wish to purchase more than one attraction ticket per person, please contact the PFY office for more information. Tickets purchased through PFY will be available during check in at the start of the conference.

Bishop and Priest Admission

As a “thank you” to any bishops and priests in attendance and in exchange for their willingness to hear confessions during the conference, we offer a 50% discounted ticket of \$30 which can be purchased at the time of registration. Clergy tickets are non-refundable after January 23, 2019, but their value may be used as the deposit for a participant ticket at any time.

Inclement Weather

In the instance that inclement weather threatens to impact the conference, the following policies apply:

- It is up to every individual group to determine if it is safe to travel to the conference.
- No refunds will be issued for groups that choose not to attend the event.
- Partnership for Youth (PFY) will make every effort to hold the conference as scheduled and will communicate any changes to all registered groups.
- Unless required by government agencies or the venue, PFY will not cancel the conference once it has begun. If the conference must be canceled for this reason, PFY will not refund registration fees for the event.

If, prior to the conference start, it must be cancelled or rescheduled, registered groups will be offered the option to attend at a rescheduled date or receive a refund of their conference registration fees. PFY is not responsible for any additional expenses the group may have incurred outside of conference registration fees paid to PFY.
